Project Description:

Design, Build, Finance & Provision of FM Services for 13 Schools

The Barnsley Schools project consisted of the design, build, finance and service of 13 new build Primary Learning Centres for Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council. The project also included the provision of full Facilities Management services, including Hard and Soft Maintenance, Catering and Grounds Maintenance, to all of the schools for the remainder of the 27 year concession period.

The schools were built over 3 phases with the last of the schools being handed over in June 2007.

These new schools replaced a number of old buildings and provides up to date learning facilities, including Information and Computing Technology learning rooms.

In all, 4600 children and 380 teachers and staff will benefit directly from the new facilities.

In May 2008, Carillion sold it's equity in Barnsley Schools to Innisfree
