### **Project Description:**

#### **Design, Build, Finance & Provision of FM Services for the Magistrates' Courts.**

This was the first magistrates' courts PFI project to go into service for the Court Service providing magistrates, custodial, staff and public facilities for the administration of justice in the East Riding of Yorkshire.

The project consists of 8 courts at Hull, 3 at Beverley and 2 at Bridlington.

The three courthouses replaced existing outdated facilities at Hull, Brough, Pocklington and Howden, to reduce funding requirements.

These courtrooms have a mixture of secure, semi-secure docks or informal facilities to reflect the varying nature of the courts business.

Compliments have been received on the quality of accommodation and service delivery from magistrates, staff, advocates and members of the public.
