**Project Description:**

Design, Build, Finance and Operate a Prison for the provision of 600 places of category B offenders

The project consisted of the provision and operation of a new 600 place category B prison at Onley, Northamptonshire.

Onley Prison Services Limited, a company jointly owned by GSL and Carillion, won the 25 year concession for the design, construction, management and financing of the new prison facility. Income to the consortium is based upon available prisoner place per day.

The prison is run on behalf of HM Prison Service and again has set new standards in design, cost effectiveness and prisoner management.

The facility has 2 house blocks each accommodating 300 prisoners, which is surrounded by a perimeter wall and ancillary buildings.
