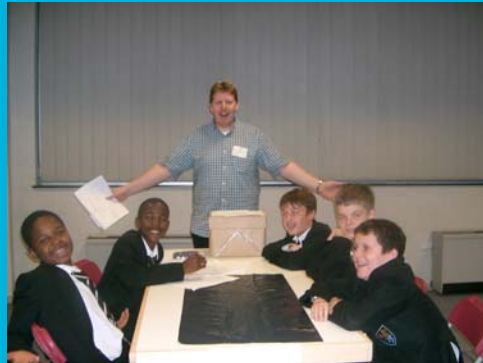

As part of Carillion's ongoing collaboration with local schools, & with the assistance of the local Education Business Partnership, the second Annual Carillion Construction Challenge was held at Westlink House, Brentford.

Eight schools entered the Challenge: Longford School, Isleworth & Syon Boys, Green School for Girls, Gumley House Catholic School, Gunnersbury Boys School, Chiswick Community College, Lampton School & St. Mark's.

The students had to choose a company name & the person who was going to be their site manager. The site manager also took the role of store keeper. The team designed & priced a structure made from items supplied in a box which included Spectrum newspapers, Construction News, string, blue tack etc. All but the site manager were allowed to build, the site manager had to design a company logo & slogan while the building was happening & was allowed to give advice but was not allowed to touch the structure.

The structures were judged on their stability, design, cost plan & marks were also awarded for neatness of working area & team working. These points were awarded by the adjudicator assigned to the team, (a Carillion employee).

The Carillion Challenge Shield was won by Lampton School of Hounslow.
