Year 7 Induction Day



As part of Carillion's ongoing collaboration with local schools, two members of staff went to the Green School in Isleworth to facilitate three sessions during the year 7 Induction Day

Nina Davidson & Tizzy Bowman of Carillion Building, Westlink House, Brentford were invited to The Green School for Girls in Isleworth, West London to participate in the Year 7 Induction Day.

There were three sessions over the course of a school day & groups of 20 students attended sessions organised & facilitated by various companies including Network Rail, Thames Water, Environment Department of the local council, local police etc.

Carillion's contribution was "Over the Bridge" using the plastic MTa construction kits. This activity promotes team building & problem solving skills.

The students were also set a challenge to build an obstacle course & a communication skills game where two students were blindfolded & two others talked them through an obstacle course made up of the remaining students.

The girls found the blindfold activity very exciting.
