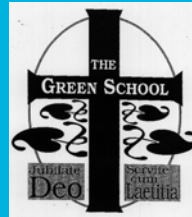

A team of Carillion employees went to the Green School in Brentford to present “Careers in Construction” to Year 10 students.

The presentation was tailored specifically to encourage females to consider entering the construction industry, not just as graduates but also as site operatives.

The presentation concentrated on common misconceptions about the industry i.e. dirty, unsafe, sexist etc. & attempted to dispel those misconceptions.

Construction Training presented on modern apprenticeships & how they work. The students were also told about the upcoming GCSE in Construction, which will be rolled out in September 2005.

There was also a presentation on graduate entry into Carillion.

Each student received a colour booklet containing pictures & descriptions of some of our most prestigious jobs & write-ups on their chosen career by some Carillion employees.

It is intended to run the presentation at various schools across the London & South area, being tailored to individual schools.
